ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

We offer three tiers of competitive cheerleading to accommodate athletes of all experience levels

NOVICE

Who it's For: Beginners or athletes who are new to competitive cheerleading. Novice teams focus on building a solid foundation of skills, including basic stunts, tumbling and cheers.

Competitions: Local competitions or low-pressure competitions. Judges provide developmental feedback and are ranked by Superior or Excellent placement.

Practice Schedule: Typically 1-2 days per week, for 1.5 hours. Practices are usually one weekday (Monday-Thursday) and/or one weekend (Friday-Sunday)

PREP

Who it's For: Athletes with some cheer experience or those looking to advance their skills and develop their technique in a competitive setting. Prep teams are often a stepping stone for athletes who may eventually move up to Elite level.

Competitions: Regional and some national competitions including premium end-of-year events such as The One or U.S. Finals.

Practice Schedule: Typically 2-3 days per week for 2 hours, usually one weekday (Monday-Thursday) and one weekend (Friday-Sunday)

ELITE

Who it's For: Experienced athletes that have a strong technical foundation. Elite teams are designed to push athletes to their peak performance levels and are known for their advanced routines and skills.

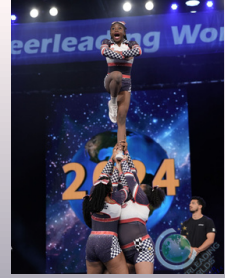
Competitions: National competitions including prestigious end-of-season events such as All-Star Worlds, Summit or World's (if eligible). All National competitions are 2-day events, with moderate travel.

Practice Schedule: Typically 3 days per week for 2 1/2-3 hours, usually two weekdays (Monday-Thursday) and one weekend (Friday-Sunday)

SEASON FINANCES

Tuition fees must be paid in full or a automatic debit monthly. Members who do not pay in full are required to put a credit card on file with the gym for monthly drafting. Payments are typically spread across 10 months. Detailed tuition schedule can be found in the Financial Obligation Document.

Regardless of enrollment dates, families will be responsible for the FULL TUITION schedule.

Monthly Tuition includes Competition entry fees, Choreography, Music, Team Tumbling, Stunt Clinic, socks, shoes, and bow.

Things not included in the monthly tuition: Competition Travel expenses & lodging, Fan Gear, and USASF Registration Fee.

Additional Cost for athletes includes (2) practice uniforms, competition uniform (Long Sleeve Crop Top, Shorts and Leotard Insert), Warm-up Suit, and backpack. All Uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle.

Fundraisers will be offered to help offset the cost.



TEAM EVALUATIONS

Team evaluations for the upcoming season will be conducted through a two-part process designed to assess each athlete's skills, performance and potential. Evaluation Cost includes try-out clinic and individual evaluation.

We understand that some athletes may be new to cheerleading, and we want to ensure everyone feels confident and supported. If you are new to the sport, please let our coaching staff know. We are more than happy to provide extra guidance and assistance throughout the process to help athletes feel prepared and successful

Athlete Attire: Black top (shirt or sports bra), Black Shorts, Cheerleading Shoes, Cheerleading Bow, No-show socks. Athletes hair should be secured in a ponytail and no jewelry.

Try-out Clinics

Try-out clinic is scheduled for April 29th and April 30th from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. During this clinic athletes will be taught a mini-routine that incorporates key elements such as jumps, tumbling and dance. Attendance at both sessions is strongly encouraged, as the routine learned will be the basis for individual evaluations.

Individual Evaluation

Individual Evaluation will take place on May 16th and May 17th. Athlete's are highly encouraged to register online, but walk-ins will be accepted. Each athlete will perform the mini-routine allowing for a comprehensive review of their technique, execution and overall performance.
